Aim of trainings:

Students majoring in primary school and kindergarten education, and social pedagogy acquire current, scientific, educational, psychological, social, administrative and legal skills during the initial training, moreover, they learn social studies and health sciences as well. These programmes also offer a wide range of specializations.

Bachelor of Lower-Primary School Teacher (1st-4th grades)

The aim of this four-year practice-oriented training is to train teachers who are well-informed about the Hungarian and European culture, who are professionally well-prepared, therefore they are able to educate 6-12 year-old children responsibly. They teach almost all subjects in the first four years of primary school and at least one literacy teaching area up to 6^{th} grade.

Bachelor of Kindergarten Teacher

The aim of this three-year practice-oriented training is to train professionals whose professional knowledge, skills and abilities fit to perform the tasks of pre-school education.

Bachelor of Socialpedagogy

This programme includes seven semesters. The aim of the practice-oriented training is to train social pedagogists who are able to handle their clients' learning, social and mental health problems in a complex system. They focus on restoring and maintaining the balance between children, young people and their social environment. The programme provides multi-disciplinary knowledge, develop those skills which are essential to prevent and resolve social problems and to promote social inclusion of participants.
