Introduction to Language Pedagogy

- 1. How do language acquisition theories influence second language teaching? What are (some of) the *classroom implications* of each theory? (universal grammar, input theory, interaction theory, output theory, cognitive theory, sociocultural theory, behaviorism)
- 2. What is communicative competence? How can language teaching aim at developing communicative competence?
- Give a brief overview of foreign language teaching methods and approaches in the past 100 years. What beliefs and/or understanding of language acquisition is each method or approach based on? (grammar-translation method, direct method, audiolingual method, total physical response, silent way, community language teaching, the communicative approach)
